Three years after the atomic bomb in Hiroshima, young librarian Mitsue lives alone, plagued by guilt and sorrow over the death of her father, who died soon after the explosion. One day, a young professor visits her library. Mitsue and the young man find themselves attracted to each other, but Mitsue fears that her grief will not allow her to be happy. When she tries to break things off, she is visited by the ghost of her father Takezo, who tries to help her overcome guilt and fear. The Face of Jizo focuses on the issue of the hibakusha, the survivors of the atomic bomb in Hiroshima who had to rebuild their lives and deal with their guilt for having survived their loved ones.
